Miró, Homage to Gaudí. Space and Colour

15 April to 4 June 2023

Shown in public for the first time, the complete series of Gaudí engravings are an outstanding collection of 21 etchings acquired by the museum between 2003 and 2022. The highly poetic and colourful series is a chance to enjoy the later work of Miró in the field of engraving, but also to explore the links uniting the two great artists, both symbols of Catalonia and Barcelona.

FROM THE EPISCOPAL PALACE TO THE 21ST CENTURY MUSEUM



The new Goya Museum is a guardian of the past and resolutely turned towards the future. After three years of renovation work, it now has a new look to welcome visitors in new, fully accessible spaces. The museum visit and staging have been completely redesigned in order to display the works in new spaces and to improve the visitor's experience.



A CENTRE FOR ART DEDICATED TO SPAIN

The Goya Museum has focused on Spanish art since 1947. Its unique qualities are highlighted in a new staging deployed over 1,500 m² and on two storeys. It presents an outstanding collection of works illustrating the art of the Iberian peninsula from the Middle Ages to today. Here, visitors can discover major artists from the history of art: Velázquez, Murillo, Goya, Picasso, Dalí, Miró, Tàpies, Barceló...

GOYA THE FOCAL POINT OF THE MUSEUM VISIT

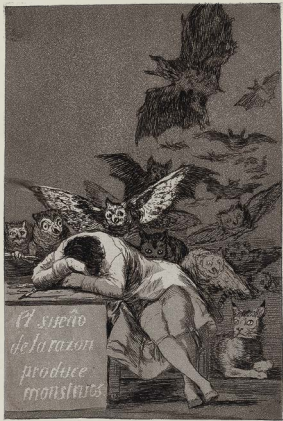
The work of Goya, a major Spanish artist, now has a room of its own. The three paintings, as well as the cabinet of graphic arts, have been brought together and are introduced by an illustrated biography of the artist and educational tools. 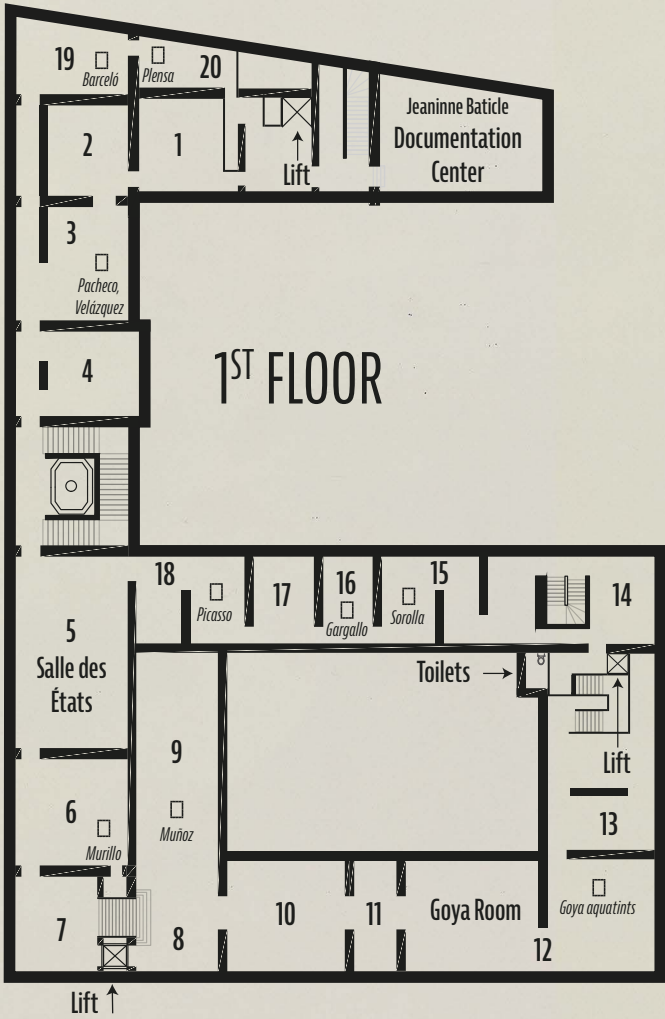
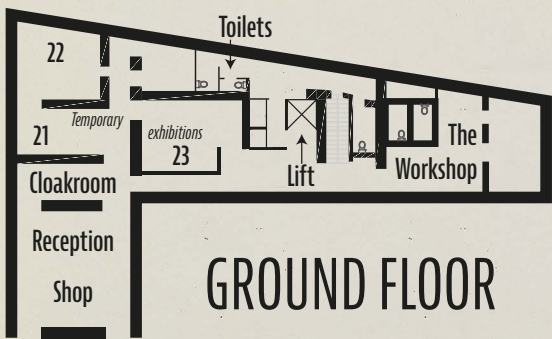
